In most cases, medical association dues may be deductible as professional or business expenses. Dues and other contributions to Washington Academy of Eye Physicians & Surgeons and/or EyePAC are not deductible as charitable contributions for federal income tax purposes.

For your records, please note that the Revenue Reconciliation Act of 1993 states that association dues used for lobbying activities are not deductible as a business expense. Thus, 50% of your WAEPS dues for 2012 cannot be deducted as a business expense for federal income tax purposes. In addition, no portion of any dues paid to Physicians EyePAC can be deducted as a business expense on your federal income tax return.

Physicians EyePAC is a separate segregated fund established by the WAEPS. Voluntary political contributions to Physicians EyePAC can be written on either corporate or personal checks. Contributions are not limited to the suggested amounts. Voluntary political contributions are subject to the limitations of FEC Regulations Sections 110.1, 110.2 and 110.5. (Federal regulations require this notice.)
